It's an emergency whenever someone exhibits:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath.
- Chest or upper abdominal pain.
- Fainting or sudden dizziness.
- Weakness or change in vision.
- Confusion, change in mental acuity.
- Severe pain.
- Bleeding that won't stop.
- Persistent vomiting or vomiting blood.
- Suicidal or homicidal feelings.
